I had been readied for Holy Week by our District Minister's (Jim's) Palm Sunday Service and, that evening, by the Choir of King's College London (CKCL) at St John's Smith Square thanks to an invite from choir member Ricky who does our IT and is Jason's younger brother. CKCL performed Rachmaninoff's All-Night Vigil. With all that's going on in Ukraine, it was most affecting to listen to sublime holy music in Russian sung so well by Ricky and his fellow students in those magnificent surroundings. My heart reached out to all those many Russians who do not support Putin's war against Ukraine, and especially to those who've been so brave in their opposition, before I thought of what an awful Easter it would be for so many Ukrainians.

On TV recently I saw an elderly Ukrainian lady lighting a candle in a cold, damp, dark basement, praying that God would protect her and her neighbours and their family pets sheltering there. Her modest plea moved me greatly. I thought of her and her guinea pig chewing obliviously on his rubbery bit of cauliflower as I made your payment of £1000 to the British Red Cross Ukrainian Appeal. Thank you for that.
